

Delete print queue

1. Open Command Prompt as **Administrator**:

*Click the Start button, type `cmd`, right-click on "Command Prompt" and select "**Run as administrator**".*

2. Stop the Print Spooler Service:

Type `net stop spooler` and press Enter.

3. Delete the Print Queue Files:

Type `del %systemroot%\System32\spool\printers /Q` and press Enter.*

4. Start the Print Spooler Service:

Type `net start spooler` and press Enter.
